EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 5.71 acres of improved real property located in Land Lots 104, 105, 120, and 121, 6th Land District, Monroe County, Georgia (hereinafter the "Property"), which Property is a portion of the 236.872 acres acquired by virtue of a Warranty Deed dated September 2, 1982, from the Forest Farms, Inc., being recorded in Deed Book 147, Pages 15 to 21 in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Monroe County and on file with the State Properties Commission Real Property Records as RPR # 007087, and which Property is under the custody of the Georgia Public Safety Training Center and is more fully described in that survey attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated June 8, 2020, the Georgia Public Safety Training Center declared the Property surplus; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated June 5, 2020, the Georgia Emergency Management Agency requested that custody of the Property be transferred from the Georgia Public Safety Training Center to the Georgia Emergency Management Agency to establish an Alternate Care Facility in support of the COVID-19 response operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That custody of the above-defined Property located in Monroe County, Georgia is hereby transferred from the Georgia Public Safety Training Center to the Georgia Emergency Management Agency.
