EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On July 13, 2020, the Honorable Terrinee L. Gundy filed a lawsuit against The Honorable Louisa Abbot; James Balli; Richard Hyde; the Honorable Stacey K. Hydrick; William Pope Langdale; The Honorable Robert McBurney; Jamala S. McFadden; Michael Register; Warren Selby; and Edward Tolley; all individually and as members of the Judicial Qualifications Commission (“JQC”) in the Superior Court of Fulton County, Civil Action No. 2020CV338280; and

WHEREAS: JQC Director, Chuck Boring, because of a conflict, has declined representation of the Honorable Robert McBurney, Richard Hyde, and Jamala S. McFadden in this case.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 45-15-70 AND BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Honorable Chris Carr, Attorney General of Georgia, is hereby appointed as Special Counsel to assume control and responsibility for the representation of the Honorable Robert McBurney, Richard Hyde, and Jamala S. McFadden; all individually and as members of the Judicial Qualifications Commission in all matters related to Judge Gundy’s *Quo Warranto* Petition.
