EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 21 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") located at 2895 Vineville Avenue, in Land Lot 29 of the Macon Reserve East, Bibb County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of an Indenture dated February 16, 1952, recorded in Deed Book 633, page 200 in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Bibb County, and filed with the State Properties Commission, Real Property Record as RPR# 00093; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Education and is commonly known as Georgia Academy for the Blind; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with two buildings known as Maintenance Engineer Residence (BLLIP ID # 4618) and Maintenance Building (BLLIP ID # 4616) as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A (hereinafter the "Structures"); and

WHEREAS: The Maintenance Engineer Residence is in poor condition has been abandoned due to health risks posed by asbestos, mold, and lead paint, and the Maintenance Building is over sixty years old and is in poor condition; and

WHEREAS: By official action dated February 10, 2021, the Georgia Department of Education requested authority to demolish the Structures.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Department of Education is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
