EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: United States Capitol Police Officer William “Billy” Evans was killed in the line of duty at the United States Capitol on Friday, April 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS: The people of Georgia are grateful for Officer Evans’ bravery, service, and sacrifice, and mourn his loss; and

WHEREAS: The people of Georgia wish to honor the life of Officer Evans as we share in the grief of his family and friends, and pray for their comfort and healing in the days to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR OFFICER EVANS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds from this date until sunset, Tuesday, April 6, 2021.
