EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Talbot County District 1 Commissioner Robert Lee Lanier was indicted on March 8, 2021, on one count of Possession of Methamphetamine; and

WHEREAS: The indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(b), and the certified copy was received on March 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following the receipt of the indictment as prescribed by O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Upson County Commissioner Norman Allen, and Turner County Commissioner Brad Calhoun are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the duties by Commissioner Lanier such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen days with a recommendation as to whether said mayor should be suspended from office as required by O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(c).
