**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN WHEELER COUNTY  
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

**WHEREAS:** Officer Dylan McCauley Harrison, 26, with the Alamo Police Department, passed away on Saturday, October 9, 2021, after being targeted following an arrest made earlier in the day; and

**WHEREAS:** In addition to his service with the Alamo Police Department, Officer Harrison also served as a narcotics agent with the Oconee Drug Task Force Agency; and

**WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Harrison's service to the City of Alamo and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Wheeler County to half-staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF OFFICER DYLAN MCCAULEY HARRISON, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Wheeler County on Friday, October 15, 2021, the day of Officer Harrison's interment, until sunset.
