EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 39.60 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") located at 1301 Constitution Road, in Land Lot 79, 15th District, DeKalb County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of a Warranty Deed dated August 9, 1974, recorded in Deed Book 3222, page 312, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of DeKalb County, and filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as RPR# 05895; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Corrections and is commonly known as Metro Reentry Facility; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with structures known as the Metro State Prison Training Storage, Block House (BLLIP ID # 694) and Pole Barn (BLLIP ID # 708), totaling 1,193 square feet as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A (hereinafter the "Structures"); and

WHEREAS: Said Structures have been abandoned, contain no salvageable equipment of value and have been identified as hazardous; and

WHEREAS: By Resolution dated September 2, 2021, the Georgia Department of Corrections requested authority to demolish the Structures.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Department of Corrections is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
