### HEALTHCARE TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT WEEK

- WHEREAS:** The increasing complexity of medical technology makes the individuals responsible for the care, safety, and accuracy of this equipment a valuable resource to the healthcare industry, and they should be recognized for their services; and
- WHEREAS:** These professionals install, inspect, and repair medical devices and implicated medical systems. They also advise and train healthcare professionals on the safe and effective use of medical devices; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Biomedical Instrumentation Society (GBIS) is a unique alliance of members united by a common goal to increase the understanding and beneficial use of healthcare instrumentation; and
- WHEREAS:** The GBIS seeks to advance the interests of biomedical equipment technicians, clinical engineers, and other medical technology professionals; now
