

House Bill 560 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Thomas County, approved
2 December 1, 1898 (Ga. L. 1898, p. 378), as amended, so as to modify the compensation of
3 the commissioners on the Thomas County Board of Commissioners; to provide for related
4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Thomas County, approved
8 December 1, 1898 (Ga. L. 1898, p. 378), as amended, is amended by revising Section 7 to
9 read as follows:

10 "SECTION 7.

11 The member of the board of commissioners of Thomas County, who is the chairperson
12 thereof, shall be compensated in the amount of \$700.00 per month, and the remaining
13 members of the board shall be compensated in the amount of \$600.00 per month, payable
14 monthly. All of such compensation and expenses shall be payable from the funds of Thomas
15 County. The board of commissioners shall submit through its chairperson to the grand jury

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16 of the county at the spring term of the superior court in each year a written statement of all
17 matters relating to the financial condition of the county, its roads, bridges, public buildings,
18 and paupers, with suggestions in regard to county affairs as it deems proper to make. The
19 records of the proceedings of the board shall be open at all times to inspection by any citizen
20 of the county. Each outgoing board member shall turn over at the expiration of his or her
21 term of office all records, books, papers, and other property of the county to his or her
22 successor in office."

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
