A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide for minimum compensation for certain county officers of
2 Pulaski County, approved April 11, 1979 (Ga. L. 1979, p. 4129), so as to revise the
3 compensation of future county officers; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to provide for minimum compensation for certain county officers of Pulaski County,
8 approved April 11, 1979 (Ga. L. 1979, p. 4129), is amended by revising Section 2 as follows:

9 "SECTION 2.

10 (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, each Pulaski County,
11 approved April 11, 1979 officer shall receive the annual minimum salary, supplements,
12 cost-of-living increases, and longevity increases provided by general law to his or her
13 respective office.

14 (b) The county commissioner of Pulaski County shall receive an annual salary equal to the
15 annual minimum salary of the sheriff.

16 (c) Each Pulaski County officer in office on the effective date of this Act shall continue
17 to receive an annual minimum salary which shall be equal to the highest minimum salary,
18 including increases based on years of service, established by any general law for any
19 Pulaski County officer. Successors to the Pulaski County officers subject to this subsection
20 shall receive compensation as provided in subsections (a), (b), and (e) of this section.

21 (d) Such salaries shall be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Pulaski
22 County.

23 (e) Each Pulaski County officer shall also be entitled to any expenses or allowances, other
24 than salary, provided by local law."

25 **SECTION 2.**

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
