## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS  
ORDERED TO HALF STAFF**

- WHEREAS:** The Honorable Madeleine Korbel Albright passed away on March 23, 2022; and
- WHEREAS:** Mrs. Albright served as the 64<sup>th</sup> U.S. Secretary of State from 1997 to 2001. She was the first female Secretary of State in U.S. history; and
- WHEREAS:** In addition to her service as Secretary of State, she also served on the National Security Council under President Jimmy Carter, and as an Ambassador to the United Nations; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Secretary Albright's service to citizens of the United States of America by lowering the flags throughout Georgia to half-staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE MADELEINE KORBEL ALBRIGHT, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

- ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds from this date until sunset on Sunday, March 27, 2022.
