## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN FULTON COUNTY  
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

**WHEREAS:** Sgt. Jean-Harold Louis Astree, 54, with the City of Fairburn Police Department, passed away on Thursday, July 28, 2022, after the vehicle he was driving was involved in a four-vehicle wreck; and

**WHEREAS:** Sgt. Astree began his law enforcement career with the Atlanta Police Department, serving from 2005-2008, and began working with the Fairburn Police Department in 2018; and

**WHEREAS:** Sgt. Astree was also a veteran of the U.S. Air Force; and

**WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Sgt. Astree's service to the City of Fairburn, the City of Atlanta, and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Fulton County to half-staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF SGT. JEAN-HAROLD ASTREE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Fulton County on Thursday, August 4, 2022, the day of Sgt. Astree's interment, until sunset.
