- WHEREAS:** American Business Women's Day was recognized in 1983 and 1986 by Congressional resolution and a proclamation issued by President Ronald Reagan; and
- WHEREAS:** Businesswomen have made significant impacts on countless companies and organizations at every level, providing expertise, leadership skills, and other invaluable contributions while working as valued colleagues, superiors, and members of the units driving our economy; and
- WHEREAS:** The holiday commemorates the legacy and contributions of millions of American working women and women business owners as well as the hard work of businesswomen within the Metro Atlanta area; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September 22, 2022, as AMERICAN BUSINESS WOMEN'S DAY in Georgia.
