### LOYALTY DAY

- WHEREAS:** This nation is kept strong and free by the citizens who preserve our American heritage through their positive patriotic declarations and action; and
- WHEREAS:** Loyal citizens should seek to inspire patriotism among all Americans, as our nation is firmly united by our shared values of freedom and justice for all; and
- WHEREAS:** Loyalty Day has been celebrated for over fifty years throughout this great nation, as designated by both Congress and the President of the United States; and
- WHEREAS:** Patriotic programs will be sponsored by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and its Auxiliary, and others; and
- WHEREAS:** On Loyalty Day, Georgians are encouraged to reaffirm their commitment to our flag, country, and the brave men and women in uniform who protect our freedom; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 1, 2022, as LOYALTY DAY in Georgia.
