

House Bill 1016 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Montgomery County, approved
2 February 27, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, Jan.-Feb. Sess., p. 2729), as amended, particularly by an
3 Act approved March 5, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 4118), so as to change the description of the
4 commissioner districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation
5 in office of current members; to provide for manner of election and terms of office; to
6 provide for related matters; to provide effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
7 other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Montgomery County, approved February 27,
11 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, Jan.-Feb. Sess., p. 2729), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
12 March 5, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 4118), is amended by revising Sections 4 and 5 as follows:

13 "SECTION 4.

14 (a) For purposes of electing members of the board, Montgomery County is divided into
15 five commissioner districts, and those districts shall be and correspond to those five

16 districts described in Appendix A attached to and made a part of this Act and further
17 identified as 'User: Montgomery Co. Plan Name: montgomeryccsb-2022 Plan Type: Local'.
18 One commissioner each shall be elected from each district by the electors of such districts.

19 (b)(1) For the purposes of such plan:

20 (A) The term 'VTD' shall mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as
21 provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial
22 census of 2020 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric designations in a district
23 description which are underneath a VTD heading shall mean and describe individual
24 Blocks within a VTD as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the
25 United States decennial census of 2020 for the State of Georgia; and

26 (B) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any district, whenever the
27 description of any district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical
28 boundaries of that city as shown on the census maps for the United States decennial
29 census of 2020 for the State of Georgia.

30 (2) Any part of Montgomery County which is not included in any district described in
31 subsection (a) of this section shall be included within that district contiguous to such part
32 which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census
33 of 2020 for the State of Georgia.

34 (3) Any part of Montgomery County which is described in subsection (a) of this section
35 as being included in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such
36 district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall
37 instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least
38 population according to the United States decennial census of 2020 for the State of
39 Georgia.

40 SECTION 5.

41 Members of the board representing Commissioner Districts 1, 2, and 3 shall be elected at
42 the November general election in 2024, take office the first day of January immediately
43 following that election, and serve for terms of office of four years and until their respective
44 successors are elected and qualified. Members of the board representing Commissioner
45 Districts 4 and 5 shall be elected at the November general election in 2022, take office the
46 first day of January immediately following that election, and serve initial terms of office
47 of four years and until their respective successors are elected and qualified. All future
48 successors to members of the board whose terms of office are to expire shall be elected at
49 the November general election immediately preceding the expiration of such terms, take
50 office the first day of January immediately following that election, and serve for terms of
51 office of four years and until their respective successors are elected and qualified.”

52 SECTION 2.

53 (a) Those members of the Board of Commissioners of Montgomery County who are serving
54 as such on the effective date of this Act and any person selected to fill a vacancy in any such
55 office shall continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their respective
56 terms of office and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors.

57 (b)(1) Commissioner Districts 1 and 2, as they exist immediately prior to the effective
58 date of this Act, shall continue to be designated as Commissioner Districts 1 and 2,
59 respectively, but as newly described under this Act, and on and after the effective date
60 of this Act, such members of the board serving from those former commissioner districts
61 shall be deemed to be serving from and representing their respective districts as newly
62 described under this Act.

63 (2) Commissioner District 3 Post 1, Commissioner District 3 Post 2, and Commissioner
64 District 4, as they exist immediately prior to the effective date of this Act, shall be
65 designated as new Commissioner Districts 3, 4, and 5, respectively, but as newly

66 described under this Act, and on and after the effective date of this Act, such members
67 of the board serving from those former commissioner districts shall be deemed to be
68 serving from and representing their respective districts as newly described under this Act.

69 **SECTION 3.**

70 The provisions of this Act necessary to conduct elections for the members of the board
71 in 2022 shall become effective upon the approval of this Act by the Governor or upon its
72 becoming law without such approval. The remaining provisions of this Act shall become
73 effective on January 1, 2023.

74 **SECTION 4.**

75 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
