



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 1,442 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") in Land Lots 106, 107, and 111 of the 8<sup>th</sup> Land District, and Land Lots 245-6, 251-5, 279-281, and 284-5 of the 19<sup>th</sup> Land District, Muscogee County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of a General Warranty Deed dated February 9, 2001, recorded in Deed Book 5789, pages 4-10 in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Muscogee County, and filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as RPR# 09602.01; and

**WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Natural Resources and is commonly known as Standing Boy Creek State Park; and

**WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with a structure formerly known as residence house (BLLIP ID # 28046), totaling 2,400 square feet as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A (hereinafter the "Structure"); and

**WHEREAS:** Said Structure needs to be demolished as the structure is no longer needed, is in poor condition, and is beyond reasonable repair; and

**WHEREAS:** By Resolution dated December 7, 2022, the Board of Natural Resources requested authority to demolish the Structure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** The Department of Natural Resources is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
