EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On July 12, 2023, Mr. Earl Jackson, Mayor of Sparks, Georgia, was indicted on two felony counts of Theft by Taking, and one felony count of Theft by Conversion; and

WHEREAS: The indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b), and the certified copy was received on July 13, 2023; and

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment as prescribed by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Chris Carr, Mayor Jason Weaver of Screven, and Mayor Travis Wimbush of Blakely are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mayor Jackson such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen days with a recommendation as to whether Mayor Jackson should be suspended from office as required by Code Section 45-5-6(c).
