



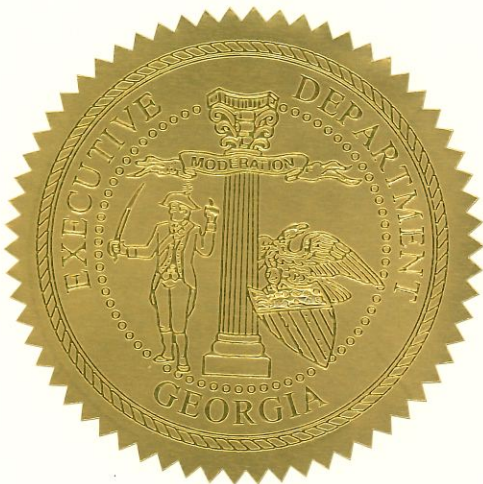

- WHEREAS:** With access to a robust and well-trained workforce, companies may enhance overall performance and productivity while also growing and sustaining competitive advantages; and
- WHEREAS:** Continuing education opportunities for employees can create improvements in individual and organizational knowledge and expertise; and
- WHEREAS:** The Association for Talent Development (ATD), the world's largest association dedicated to those who develop talent in organizations, has designated Employee Learning Week as a time for organizations to recognize the value of employee learning.
