GEORGIA TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION DAY

- WHEREAS:** Georgia's technology industry and its culture of innovation are key components in the continued financial growth of businesses across the state and a vital link in Georgia's economy; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia is committed to fostering the development and success of technology sectors and their ability to create, expand, and sustain leading technological innovations that positively impact the economy and our quality of life; and
- WHEREAS:** The Technology Association of Georgia (TAG) hosts The Summit annual event to create a forum for Georgia's technology leaders to gain and share knowledge around emerging technologies that foster innovation and to recognize Georgia's top innovative companies; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Technology Summit event inducts new members into the Technology Hall of Fame and includes the issuance of an annual State of the Industry: Technology in Georgia report to highlight Georgia's technology strengths; and
- WHEREAS:** The Summit's mission includes addressing the success and development of key workforce initiatives that foster the growth of technology industry; and
- WHEREAS:** TAG, through its mission, is dedicated to fueling the innovation economy in Georgia through continued collaboration with its 30,000 members in the technology industry; now
