WHEREAS: DECAL has partnered with local school systems and private childcare centers

in Georgia to create and support 200 inclusion classrooms in Georgia's Pre-K Program and developed resources and a network of professionals to help

teachers meet the needs of every child in their care; and

capacity of programs, providers, families, and communities to support children

with disabilities in high-quality, inclusive environments in Georgia; and

WHEREAS: During this impactful week DECAL will support early learning professionals,
