EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at Georgia Southern University's Herty Advanced Materials Development Center, Chatham County, Savannah, Georgia, six (6) buildings identified as #705, 706, 707, 708, 709, and 710 (collectively, the "Buildings"), located at 110 Brampton Road; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents' Policy 9.8.2.3 DEMOLITION authorizes the Chancellor or Vice Chancellor for Facilities to declare buildings, structures and other improvements no longer advantageously useful to the University System of Georgia. Said Buildings are included within this policy; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined by Ms. Sandra Lynn Neuse, Vice Chancellor for Real Estate and Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that said Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Georgia Southern University or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from Georgia Southern University's Herty Advanced Materials Development Center, Chatham County, Savannah, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Georgia Southern University, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
