A PROCLAMATION

ENROLLED AGENTS' WEEK

- WHEREAS:** The Enrolled Agent profession dates to 1884 when the U. S. Congress passed legislation to regulate persons who represented citizens in dealings with the U. S. Treasury Department; and
- WHEREAS:** Enrolled Agents are licensed by the U. S. Department of the Treasury to help taxpayers with the annual filing of tax returns and more complex issues like audits, liens, levies, appeals, and collections; and
- WHEREAS:** Individuals must pass a comprehensive examination on the U. S. Tax Code or have served with the Internal Revenue Service for five or more years to become Enrolled Agents; and
- WHEREAS:** Enrolled Agents intelligently and ethically represent hardworking taxpayers before government agencies, benefitting both Georgia taxpayers and the Georgia Department of Revenue; and
- WHEREAS:** During Enrolled Agent Week, organizations including the Georgia Association of Enrolled Agents recognize Enrolled agents for their role in serving the state of Georgia and hardworking citizens; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 7-13, as ENROLLED AGENTS' WEEK in Georgia.
