- WHEREAS:** The Summit event inducts new members into the Technology Hall of Fame and includes the issuance of an annual State of the Industry: Technology in Georgia report to highlight Georgia's technology strengths.
- WHEREAS:** The Summit's mission includes addressing the success and development of key workforce initiatives that foster the growth of technology industry; and
- WHEREAS:** TAG, through its mission, is dedicated to fueling the innovation economy in Georgia through continued collaboration with its 30,000 members in the technology industry and celebrating its milestone 25th anniversary; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 28, 2024, as GEORGIA DAY in Georgia.
