## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** On June 11, 2024, Mrs. Stephanie Lindsey, County Commissioner for Newton County, was indicted by the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia on one count of Money Laundering Conspiracy, one count of Transactional Money Laundering, one count of Concealment Money Laundering, and two counts of Making and Subscribing a False Tax Return; and

**WHEREAS:** A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b), and received on January 2, 2025; and

**WHEREAS:** The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment as prescribed by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Clinton Johnson of the Dougherty County Board of Commissioners, and Bruce Henry of the Jasper County Board of Commissioners are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mrs. Lindsey such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen days with a recommendation as to whether Mrs. Lindsey should be suspended from office as required by Code Section 45-5-6(c).
