EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN
CHATHAM COUNTY, GEORGIA
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Sgt. Kelvin Ansari of the Savannah Police Department was killed in the line of duty on Saturday, May 11, 2019, while responding to a robbery call; and

WHEREAS: Sgt. Ansari was 21-year veteran of the U.S. Army and a 10-year veteran of the Savannah Police Department. He was recognized as Detective of the Year in 2018 and was later promoted to the rank of sergeant; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Sgt. Ansari's service to the citizens of Chatham County, the State of Georgia, and the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF SGT. KELVIN ANSARI, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Chatham County, Georgia, on Saturday, May 18, 2019, the day of Sgt. Ansari's interment, until sunset.
