EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at the Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia, two buildings located at 828 & 830 West Peachtree Street (the "Buildings"); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents, at its meeting on May 14, 2019, declared that said Buildings could no longer be advantageously used by the Georgia Institute of Technology or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove said Buildings from the Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of the Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish said Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
